

Data Usage Policy: Privacy Policy (processing of personal data of visitors and users) brought into compliance according to the GDPR of May 25, 2018.

What types of information do we collect?

We collect information when you register on our site, when you log in to your account, the information collected includes your name, email address, phone number, mailing address, association / company name (your SIRET, your VAT number), your job title, and if applicable your payment methods.

In addition, we automatically receive and record information from your computer and browser, including your IP address, software and hardware, and the page you request via Google Analytics and visitor reporting for [a period of 20 years](#).

How do we use this information?

Any information we collect from you may be used to:

- Contact you by e-mail
- Administer a contest, a promotion, or a survey, manage your quotes, orders, deliveries, invoices and payments

How is this information shared?

We are the sole owners of the information collected on this site.

Your personal information will not be sold, traded, transferred, or given to any other company for any reason without your consent, other than what is necessary to fulfill a request and/or transaction, such as to ship an order or validate an online payment.

What is our legal basis for processing data?

We collect, use and share data in our possession in the ways described below:

- To the extent necessary to comply with our terms of use
- In accordance with your consent, which you may revoke at any time by email or telephone (see legal notice)
- To the extent necessary to fulfill our legal obligations;

- To protect your vital interests or those of others;
- To the extent necessary in the public interest;
- To the extent necessary for our legitimate interests (or those of others), including our interests in providing an innovative, personalized, secure and beneficial service to our users and partners, unless those interests are overridden by your interests or fundamental rights and freedoms requiring the protection of your personal data.

Protection of Information

We implement a variety of security measures to keep your personal information safe. We use state-of-the-art encryption to protect sensitive information transmitted online. We also protect your information offline. Only employees who need to perform a specific job (for example, billing or customer service) have access to personally identifiable information. The computers and servers used to store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.

Data Retention, Deactivation and Account Deletion

We store data until it is no longer necessary to provide our services and Products, or until your account is deleted whichever comes first. This is a case-by-case decision that depends on aspects such as the nature of the data, the reason for its collection and processing, and the relevant legal or operational retention needs. For example, we retain data from your contact form submissions **for 10 years**.

Your rights

You have the right to receive a copy of your Personal Data in our possession ("right of access"). You may also request the deletion of your Personal Data and the rectification of erroneous or obsolete Personal Data ("right of deletion and right of rectification"). Please note that we may retain certain information about you when required by law or when we have a legitimate reason to do so. For example, if we believe that you have committed fraud or violated our Terms of Use and we want to prevent you from circumventing the rules applicable to our community. You also have the right to object at any time for reasons relating to his or her particular situation, (i) to the processing of your Personal Data for direct marketing purposes or to processing carried out on the basis of our legitimate interest ("right to object"). You have the right to limit the processing of your Personal Data ("right to limitation"). Please note that this right only applies if (1) you challenge the accuracy of your Personal Data during the period of time required for us to verify its accuracy; (2) in the event of unlawful processing by us and

you request a restriction of their use rather than erasure; (3) we no longer need the Personal Data for the purpose of processing but they are still required by you for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims; (4) in the event of the exercise of your right to object for the duration of the verification as to whether the legitimate reasons we are pursuing prevail over yours. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority or to obtain redress from the competent courts if you consider that we have not respected your rights. You also have the right to the portability of your data, i.e. the right to receive the Personal Data you have provided to us in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and the right to transmit this data to another data controller ("portability right"). You also have the right to define directives concerning the fate of your Personal Data after your death. To exercise these rights, you may contact the controller of the Personal Data in the manner set forth in the "Contact" section.
